


You probably already know that ...

- ◆ The NCLB Act and Michigan legislation requires all school districts to write a district technology plan in order to receive funding.
- ◆ Recent additions to the legislation include more requirements for writing technology plans and less time to meet the deadlines.
- ◆ All Michigan school districts are required to have a certified technology plan prior to the start of the next school year in which they receive funds.
- ◆ New FCC rules require that your technology plan is written prior to filing the 470 E-rate Form for the year funds are requested.
- ◆ Your district technology plan must include goals and strategies for enhancing teaching and learning.
- ◆ Your district technology plan must be monitored and evaluated annually to determine the success of the plan goals.
